<u>04</u> 25.02.2020-	Accused (1) Md. Naushad, (2) Md. Insar, (3) Md. Azad, (4) Md. Shamshad, (5) Most. Garni Khatoon are in attendance. Case called out for hearing on framing of charge. The learned counsels for both sides are present. The learned P.P. opens his case by describing charge brought against the accused persons and stating the materials available in case diary by which he proposes to prove the guilty of the accused persons. Heard both the sides and perused the record and hearing the submissions made by the learned lawyer for the accused persons and prosecution, this case does not appear to be one in which the accused persons should be discharged. I am of the opinion that there is sufficient grounds for presuming that the accused persons have committed an offence punishable under section 366A/34, 363/34 of Indian Penal Code and they have been charged thereunder. The offence under section 366A of Indian Penal Code can exclusively be triable by the court of Sessions. Charges under section 366A/34, 363/34 of Indian Penal Code framed against the
