Order

1. Anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is apprehending his arrest in connection with CA Case no. 811/2016 u/s 498(A) of IPC.

2. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has also filed his bail petition stating there in that petitioner is quite innocent having no criminal history and has falsely been implicated in the present case. It was further submitted that the complainant has brought this false case only to harass and extort the petitioner in collusion with her present husband and some other mischievous persons. Accordingly prayed for grant of bail.

3. Ld. Counsel for the State while opposing the bail petition submitted that there is allegation against petitioner to harass the complainant mentally and physically over non fulfillment of dowry demands. Therefore he does not deserved to be released on bail.

4. Heard and perused the case record from perusal it is evident that this case has been lodged u/s 498(A) of IPC. Petitioner is the husband of the complainant. Petitioner has no criminal history mentioned in para 3 of his bail petition. The matter was sent to mediation, but the mediation failed due

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to lack of interest from both parties. The petitioner also appeared in the Court and admitted that he is ready to keep complainant with him. Moreover this is a complaint case. Therefore considering the above facts and circumstances of the case discussed above, I find it proper to **Allow this Anticipatory Bail Petition**. Petitioner is directed to be released in case of his arrest/surrender within the period of four weeks from the date of receiving this order in the Court Concerned on his furnishing bail bonds of **Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties** like amount each to the satisfaction of Court concerned.
