ORDER

An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Md. Tanveer @ Md. Tanveer Ali, S/O Md. Sariful Haque, (2) Md. Shamshad, S/O Md. Saiful, (3) Md. Rayeesh, S/O Md. Saiful, (4) Md. Saiful, S/O Late Md. Chhagar, (5) Md. Rohit, S/O Md. Anwar, (6) Md. Tazmul, S/O Md. Shakil, (7) Md. Murtuz, S/O Md. Shakil, (8) Md. Jainul, S/O Md. Tahir, (9) Md. Hasbul, S/O Md. Tahir, (10) Md. Aktar, S/O Md. Jainul, (11) Md. Kaif, S/O Md. Jainul, (12) Md. Ainul, S/O Md. Tahir, (13) Pramod Poddar, S/O Bhola Poddar and (14) Styam Kumar, S/O Pramod Poddar who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Mansahi P.S. Case No21/2026 for the offences registered U/s 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS. The copy of the same has already been duly served to the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State.

Heard the Ld. counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The Ld. counsel of the petitioners have submitted that earlier, no B.P. or A.B.P. on behalf of the accused petitioners have been filed or moved before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence at all and have been falsely implicated in this case due to land dispute. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. That there is case and counter blast case amongst the parties. That the petitioner Md. Tanveer Ali is student and preparing for competitive exams. That there is not specific allegation against any of the petitioners. That Section 118(1), 109, 308(2) is not applicable against these petitioners and other sections are bailable in nature. Petitioners are ready and willing to abide by the terms and conditions laid down by this court. Petitioners are ready to furnish local and solvent bailors to the court satisfaction. Accordingly, prayed to grant bail.

On the other hand, the Ld. Addl. P.P. vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the above named accused petitioners and submitted that the petitioners have committed the alleged offence under well planned manner. Hence, it is requested to reject the petition of the above named accused petitioners.

The case of the prosecution, in brief, is that on 20.01.2026 at about 03:00 PM, land measurement was scheduled in the presence of the Amin and Manihari Police. During document verification at the site, Md. Tanveer, Md. Samsad, Md.

Raees, Md. Saiful, Md. Rohit, Md. Tajmul, Md. Murtoz, Md. Jainul, Md. Hasbul and Md. Enul arrived and assaulted them. The accused had earlier demanded Rs. 4,00,000/- (four lakh) as extortion and upon refusal, attacked the informant. They have no connection with the disputed land and were focibly demanding money. Hence, the present case.

Heard the Ld. Counsel of both the parties and perused the case diary. The instant Mansahi P.S. Case No. 21/2026 has been registered U/S 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 76, 125(b), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS. The petitioners are the named accused of the FIR, however there are general and omnibus allegations against these petitioners. The case diary shows that there is land dispute between the parties and they have filed case and counter case for the same incident. Injury found at the body of the victim are simple in nature and petitioners are not any criminal antecedent. They are ready to cooperate into investigation and trial of the present case. There is no chance of absconding or tampering with the evidence by these petitioners.

Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, the present anticipatory bail petition of the above named accused petitioners are hereby **allowed** and the petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender **within four (4) weeks of this order**, shall be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court.
