ORDER

An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Gaurav Raja, S/O Md. Tullu and (2) Akram Raja @ Lalu, S/O Md. Tullu who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Amdabad P.S. Case No. 22/2026 for the offences registered U/S 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 76, 125(b), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS. The copy of the same has already been duly served to the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State.

Heard the Ld. counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The Ld. counsel of the petitioners have submitted that earlier, no B.P. or A.B.P. on behalf of the accused petitioners have been filed or moved before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence at all and have been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. That there is counter blas case of Amdabad P.S. Case No. 21/2026 duly filed by accused petitioner Akram Raja against informant of this case. That the infromant is the full brother of the petitioners and there is land dispute is created between them. Petitioners are ready and willing to abide by the terms and conditions laid down by this court. Petitioners are ready to furnish local and solvent bailors to the court satisfaction. Accordingly, prayed to grant bail.

On the other hand, the Ld. Addl. P.P. vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the above named accused petitioners and submitted that the petitioners have committed the alleged offence under well planned manner. Hence, it is requested to reject the petition of the above named accused petitioners.

The case of the prosecution, in brief, is that on 20.01.2026 at about 07:00 hrs, while the informant Md. Kasif Raja was absent, accused Akram Raja

unlawfully entered his house with ill intent and misbehaved with his wife, tearing her clothes. Akram Raja returned along with co-accused Raurav Raja, Sk. Mantu, Aftab, Sk.Saja, Raju and Sk. Tajmal, all armed with lathi and danda and assaulted the informant's wife. The accused also snatched a silver necklace worth Rs. 3,500/-. During the occurrence, the victim's clothes were again torn. Hence, the present case.

Heard the Ld. Counsel of both the parties and perused the case diary. The instant Amdabad P.S. Case no. 22/2026 has been registered U/S 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 76, 125(b), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS The petitioners are named accused of the FIR, but there is general and omnibus allegation against these petitioners. The main allegation is against the accused namely Saju. Doctor has found lacerated wound at the forehead of victim which is simple in nature. These petitioners have not any criminal antecedent and they are ready to cooperate into investigation and trial of the present case. There is no chance of absconding or tampering with the evidence by these petitioners.

Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, the present anticipatory bail petition of the above named accused petitioners are hereby allowed and the petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender **within four (4) weeks of this order**, shall be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court.
