ORDER

10.04.2026- This criminal Misc. petition has been filed on the behalf of accused-petitioners namely 1. Badshah Alam 2. Md. Afsar Alam 3. Md. Mahimuddin 4. Afsana Khatoon 5. Noorie Khatoon 6. Sona Khatoon 7. Firdoshi Khatoon and the copy of said petition has already been provided to the Ld. A.P.P. for the state.

Heard the ld. counsel **Shri Rauf Mansoori** appearing on the behalf of the petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. **Shri Azaj Alam** appearing on the behalf of the state.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted before this court that aforesaid all seven accused-petitioners granted anticipatory bail vide order passed in A.B.P. no. 1134/2025 and they were directed to surrender before the court within three weeks of the order dated 05.01.2026. But petitioners were out of house for earning their livelihood hence they could not surrender and file bail bonds before the concerned learned court within stipulated period. Petitioners have not made delay deliberately and knowingly. Accordingly it has been prayed for extending the period for surrendering as well as furnishing the bail bonds.

Per contra, learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for extending the period for surrendering and furnishing bail bond.

Heard the both parties and perused the record. From perusal of the original record relating to A.B.P. no. 1134/2025 it is quite clear that by its order dated 05.01.2026 court granted anticipatory bail of aforesaid all petitioners and ordered to release the petitioners on bail in the case of surrender/arrest within three weeks of this order on furnishing of bail bond as directed in said order. Since Ld. Counsel for the petitioners have submitted that all petitioners were out of district for earning their livelihood due to that very reason they could not appear and file bail bond as per directions. So, having consideration the above facts this petition is

hereby allowed with Rs. 1400/- cost and accordingly the period for surrendering before the court is hereby extended and accused-petitioners is directed to surrender before court within three weeks of this order. While the other conditions will remain unchanged and the said cost will be deposited in the office of D.L.S.A., Katihar and the receipt relating to depositing the cost will be submitted with bail bonds.
