ORDER

26-03-2026 This petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the accused namely Taukir Alam and Manowar Alam who are in custody since 24.02.2026 in connection with Balrampur P.S. Case No. 24/2026 instituted U/S- 115 (2), 126 (2), 109 (1), 118 (1), 117 (1), 74, 3 (5) of B.N.S.

Heard the learned counsel Shri A.K. Jha appearing on behalf of the petitioners and learned A.P.P. Shri Md. Ajaz Alam appearing on behalf of the State and perused the lower court record along with case diary.

According to F.I.R., the prosecution case in brief is that, informant to this case namely Shabnam Parween lodged a written report before S.H.O. Balrampur to this effect that accused-petitioner namely Taukir Alam and Manowar Alam used to do quarrel on trifle matters and they also do not follow the social decision. Informant has further alleged that on dated 23.02.2026 at about 09:00 o'clock in morning she was going at that time they abused her and when she forbade them then they assaulted her by means of slaps and having hold her hair started scuffling with her and they also tore her clothes and when her gotni Poonam and her husband Firoz came to save then they also assaulted aforesaid both persons as well as her devar Md. Rizwan due to which there is pain in whole body and there is also swelling on the finger of both hands and one finger of left hand also got injured and the accused person also broke the five teeth of her cousin father-in-law namely Najiruddin. Informant has further alleged that Taukir Alam gave a blow of knife on her abdomen which hit at navel area due to which there is abrasion on that very part. Further, Manowar Alam gave a blow of saria on her head due to which his head got

injured.

On the other side learned counsel for the petitioners has reiterated all the grounds taken in the bail petition and has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and they have committed no offence at all. They have falsely been implicated in this case. The facts as shown by the informant in the petition are false and concocted. There is a dispute related to road between the informant and the petitioner and due to same this case has been brought. Petitioner No. 1 namely Taukir Alam has lodged a counter-blast case against the informant and others, the same is numbered as Balrampur P.S. Case No. 25/2026. The photocopy of F.I.R. is enclosed in the petition. All sections are bailable in nature except Section 109 (1), 118 (1) and 74 of B.N.S. and for making the case more serious these sections were added. They are in custody since 24.02.2026. Accordingly, prayer has been made to allow the bail petition.

Per contra, learned A.P.P. appearing for the state has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both the parties at length and perused the entire case record. From perusal of the case record it is evident that injuries sustained by all the injured to this case have been reported to be simple in nature, only the injury of Md. Quazi Rizwan have been reported to be grievous in nature but same is on left index finger measuring 0.5 cm. Further, in the injury report of Md. Najiruddin has never given any injury about the teeth and there is a counter-case between both the parties. Further, both accused persons are in custody since 24.02.2026.

So having considered the above facts the bail petition is hereby allowed and it is ordered to release the petitioners namely Taukir Alam and Manowar Alam on bail on furnishing of Rs. 10,000 with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court.
