Order

1. This regular bail petition dated 09-03-2026 has been filed u/s 483 of BNSS on behalf petitioner namely **Sonu Kumar @ Chotu Kumar** for grant of Regular Bail in connection with Barari P.S. case No. 17/2026 u/s 303(2), 317(2) of BNS. Accused/petitioner is in judicial custody since 19-01-2026.

2. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has also filed his bail petition stating there in that petitioner is quite innocent having no criminal antecedants and has falsely been implicated in this case. It was further submitted that petitioner's cultivable land is near the house of the informant and due to pani patwan dispute the said informant has implicated this petitioner in a false case. This petitioner is languishing in custody since 19.01.2026 and Accordingly prayed for grant of bail.

3. Ld. APP while opposing the bail petition submitted that there is allegation against petitioner to have attempted to steal the informant's water irrigation motor pump and therefore he does not deserve to be released on bail.

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4. Heard and perused the case record from perusal it is evident that this case has been lodged U/sec 303(2), 317(2) of BNS. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 19.01.2026. Petitioner has no any prior criminal history as mentioned in para 3 of his bail petition. Moreover this is only a matter of production cum seizure list. Therefore considering the above facts and circumstances, and period of custody, let this Petitioner be **enlarged on bail** on his furnishing bail bonds of **Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties** like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.
