ORDER

A regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely (1) Rahul Kr. Sah, S/O Manoj Sah, who is in jail custody since 06.02.2026 in connection with Katihar Nagar P.S. Case No. 71/2020 for the offence registered U/S 341, 323, 324, 307, 379 of the I.P.C. The copy of the same has already been duly served to the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State.

Heard the Ld. counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The Ld. counsel of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna on 21.07.2022 in Criminal Misc. No. 25608/2021 and he was directed to appear before the learned trial court within six weeks from the date of order, but petitioner had gone out of village for his livelihood and as such, he could not appear before the court of Ld. C.J.M., Katihar within time and later on, he was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 06.02.2026. No B.P. on behalf of the accused petitioner has been filed or moved earlier before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. Petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner and the injury sustained by the informant is simple in nature. Petitioner has no any criminal history. Petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 06.02.2026. The petitioner is local man and no chance of his absconding. The petitioner is ready to furnish local and solvent bailors to the satisfaction of the court. Accordingly, prayed to grant bail.

On the other hand, the Ld. Addl. P.P. vehemently opposed the prayer of B.P. filed on behalf of the above named accused petitioner and submitted that the petitioner has committed the alleged offence under well planned manner. Hence, it is requested to reject the petition of the above named accused petitioner.

The case of the prosecution, in brief, is that in the night of 23.01.2020, accused Rahul Kr. Sah called the informant with regard to return his money as he had taken from him and when he met the petitioner, he inflicted knife upon the informant which hit on

his abdomen, thereafter the informant medically treated at Sadar Hospital, Katihar. Hence, the present case.

Heard rival submission of the Ld. counsel on behalf of the accused petitioner and the Ld. Add. P.P. for the State and perused the L.C.R. The present Katihar Nagar P.S. Case No. 71/2020 has been registered U/S 341, 323, 324, 307, 379 of the I.P.C. against the accused petitioner. The petitioner is the named accused of the FIR but there is no grievous injury on the body of the informant rather from perusal of injury report, it appears that the injury sustained by the injured informant is simple in nature. Moreover, petitioner was earlier granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna on 21.07.2022 in Criminal Misc. No. 25608/2021 and he was directed to appear before the learned trial court within six weeks from the date of order, but petitioner could not appear before the court of Ld. C.J.M., Katihar within time and later on, he was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 06.02.2026. Furthermore, the allegation of snatching away Rs. 800/- from the informant appears to be exaggeration. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 06.02.2026. There is no chance of absconding or tampering of evidence and petitioner is ready to cooperate during course of investigation and trial of this case.

Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances as well as the period of custody, I find it judicious to enlarge the above named accused petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below.
