**Order**

1. This regular bail petition has been filed u/s 483 of BNSS on behalf of above named petitioner for grant of Regular Bail in connection with Pranpur P.S. case No. 293/2025 u/s 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 351(3) of BNS. Accused/petitioner is in judicial custody since 13-02-2026.

2. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has also filed his bail petition stating there in that petitioner is quite innocent having no criminal history and has falsely been implicated in this case by the informant. It was further submitted that other co-accused persons have been granted bail vide BP no. 68/2026 by this Court only. This petitioner is in languishing in custody since 13-02-2026 and Accordingly prayed for grant of bail.

3. Ld. APP while opposing the bail petition submitted that there is allegation against petitioner to assault the informant's husband with the intention to kill. Therefore he does not deserve to be released on bail.

4. Heard and perused the case record from perusal it is evident that this case has been lodged u/s 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 351(3) of BNS. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 13-02-2026. There is case and counter case between both the parties. Out of three injuries report mentioned in para 22 of the case diary, two of which are simple in nature. Moreover other co-accused persons have already been granted bail vide BP no. 68/2026 by this Court only. Therefore considering the above facts and circumstances, let this Petitioner be **enlarged on bail** on his furnishing bail bonds of **Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties** like amount each to the satisfaction of Court Concerned.
