ORDER

01-04-2026- These aforesaid both bail petitions have been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners namely Rahul Mansuri and Md. Nafique Alam who are in custody since 28.01.2026 and 19.02.2026 respectively in connection with aforesaid case. Since, both bail petitions are arising out from same and one case Barari P.S. Case no. 274/2024. So, both bail petitions are hereby disposed of by this one order.

Heard the ld. counsels Shri Mahanand Yadav appearing on behalf of the petitioners and learned A.P.P. Shri Md. Ajaz Alam appearing on behalf of the State.

As per written report lodged by informant namely Pankaj Chaudhary, prosecution case in nutshell is that on 11.09.2024 at about 12:00 to 01:00 P.M. in night having laced with gun, country-made pistol and other weapons, seven to six persons got entered into the house of informant having covered on their respective face and on the point of pistol they snatched gold necklace from the mother of informant. Further, accused persons snatched earring, jhumka and mangalsutra from informant's wife and they also snatched gold chain and one another gold ornament from informant and thereby they took away ornaments worth about 4 to 5 lakhs and Rs. 5,00,000/- in cash.

It would be pertinent to mention herein that on the basis of written report, F.I.R. was lodged against the unknown person and during the investigation name

of both petitioners has been surfaced in this case.

On the other side learned counsels for the petitioners have reiterated all the grounds taken in the bail petition and have submitted that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence at all. The petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case without any reliable evidence and nothing incriminating articles have been recovered from the possession of both petitioners and both petitioners have no criminal history. It has been further submitted that both petitioners are in custody since 28.01.2026 and 19.02.2026 respectively. Accordingly, it has been prayed to allow both bail petitions.

Per contra, learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both parties and perused the case record from perusal of the case record it is evident that, both accused-petitioners are not named accused of F.I.R. and their names have been surfaced in this case on the basis of confessional statement made by co-accused and it is alleged that one country-made pistol used in alleged dacoity was recovered from possession of accused-petitioners but nothing on record to show that said arms were used in this alleged occurrence. Further, any looted articles has not been recovered from the possession of petitioners and accused-petitioners are in custody since 28.01.2026 and 19.02.2026 respectively.

So having considered the above facts the bail petition is hereby allowed and it is ordered to release the petitioners namely Rahul Mansuri and Md. Nafique Alam on bail on furnishing of Rs. 10,000 with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court.
