**ORDER**

**04.05.2026-** This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on the behalf of accused-petitioners namely **1. Sanjoor Alam, S/o Mohsin 2. Nazir Alam, S/o Mohsin 3. Nurshed Alam @ Nurshid Alam S/o Mohsin 4. Mukhtar Alam S/o Abdul Sattar 5. Lal Mohammad S/o Late Khan Mohd.** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with aforesaid case.

Heard the Ld. counsel Shri Sumit Kumar Mukharji appearing on the behalf of the petitioners and Ld. A.P.P. Shri Md. Azaj Alam on the behalf of the state.

According to informant, prosecution case in nutshell is that informant to this case namely Gulam Mustafa before S.H.O. Abadpur to this effect that on dated 31.12.2021 at about 08:30 O'clock in day accused-petitioners namely **1. Sanjoor Alam, S/o Mohsin 2. Nazir Alam, S/o Mohsin 3. Nurshed Alam @ Nurshid Alam S/o Mohsin 4. Mukhtar Alam S/o Abdul Sattar 5. Lal Mohammad S/o Late Khan Mohd.** And other accused named in written application were cutting the bamboo from the land of informant. Informant has further alleged that one accused namely Rejabul was demanding five lakh rupees in rangdari and he also paid one lakh rupees. Informant has further alleged that accused persons on alleged date of occurrence had cut ten bamboo worth two thousands rupees and when he forbade them then all started abusing him and Rejabul gave a blow of Bamboo on his head due to which he got injured and blood started oozing out. When his brother Karimul Haque came to save then accused-petitioner Md. Sanjoor threw down and assaulted him by the fist and leg and one Abdul Hasan caught hold to the Karimul's wife with bad intention and petitioner namely Lal Mohammad tore her saree and blouse and thereby outraged her modesty. Further, Mukhtar Alam took out eighty thousand rupees from his house and also damaged his house and demanded four lakh rupees in rangdari.

On the other side learned counsel for the petitioners has reiterated all the

grounds taken in the bail petition and has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence at all. He has further submitted that the allegation as levelled against the petitioners are totally false, fabricated and concocted. It has further submitted that case is related to land dispute, so there was a claim and counter claim in between the parties. He has further submitted that the instant case as well as the Gr. no. 2430/2019 filed by the informant's side against the petitioners vide Abadpur P.S. Case no. 42/2024 but the aforesaid case was also finalized by the police, so from the circumstances, informant filed case again and again by himself and with the help of the brother namely Sahid. He has further submitted that the same matter of land dispute the mother of the petitioner no. (4) Mukhtar Alam also filed Abadpur P.S. case no. 84/2019 GR. No. 2431/2019 against the informant and others but the same is also pending in the court of Smt. Priety Kumari JM 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Katihar. It has further submitted that all the offences are bailable in nature except section 307 of the I.P.C. but the same is not made out against the petitioners. Accused-petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. Accordingly, it has been prayed to allow the said anticipatory bail petition.

Per contra, Learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard both parties and perused the case record. From the perusal of the case record it is evident that allegation of theft as well as molestation, as levelled against the petitioners has not been found to be true during the investigation and it has been never alleged that they assaulted to the informant. While the injuries sustained by other victim to this case is simple in nature.

So having considered the above facts and submissions made by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners, the instant anticipatory bail petition is hereby allowed and accordingly it is ordered to release the petitioners namely **1. Sanjoor Alam, S/o Mohsin 2. Nazir Alam, S/o Mohsin 3. Nurshed Alam @ Nurshid Alam S/o Mohsin 4. Mukhtar Alam S/o Abdul Sattar 5. Lal Mohammad S/o Late Khan Mohd.** on bail in the case of surrender/arrest within three weeks of this order on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned subject to the condition as mentioned in the section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C., with additional condition that petitioners will furnish an undertaking with bail bond to this effect that in future, they will not commit any offence of similar nature either against informant or his family members.
