ORDER

12.05.2026- This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on the behalf of accused-petitioners namely **1. Md. Sahabuddin, 2. Md. Sahanul, 3. Md. Anisul, 4. Kahinoor Khatoon, 5. Nazma Khatoon, 6. Noor Bahaar Khatoon and 7. Robeda Khatoon** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with aforesaid case.

Heard the Ld. counsel Shri Sanjay Kumar Singh appearing on the behalf of the petitioners and Ld. A.P.P. Shri Md. Azaj Alam on the behalf of the state.

The prosecution case, in brief is that, informant to this case namely Md. Jabelul Ali lodged a written report before S.H.O. Kachna to this effect that on dated 06.02.2026 at about 02:00 O'clock in day when he went to see his home then accused-petitioners namely 1. Md. Sahabuddin, 2. Md. Sahanul, 3. Md. Anisul, 4. Kahinoor Khatoon, 5. Nazma Khatoon, 6. Noor Bahaar Khatoon and 7. Robeda Khatoon having laced with sword iron pipe and Khanti came and attacked him. Md. Sahabuddin made attack with iron rod and Sahanul made attack from sword and cut her leg. Anisul repeatedly inflicted Khanti and his brother was assaulted by sword due to which his hand and head got injured. Relating to said land hearing is going on at Barsoi Anchal.

On the other side learned counsel for the petitioners has reiterated all the grounds taken in the bail petition and has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence at all. He has further submitted that the petitioners have no role in the said occurrence and the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that from perusal of the F.I.R. it transpires that the allegation in the F.I.R. are general and omnibus in nature and during the course of investigation not a single evidence found by the investigation officer regarding the involvement of the petitioner. He has further submitted that there is case and counter case between the both parties and the prosecution has not attributed any

specific role to each of the petitioners. Accused-petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. Accordingly, it has been prayed to allow the said anticipatory bail petition.

Per contra, Learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard the both parties at length and perused the entire case record alongwith case dairy. From record it is quite clear that specific allegation has been levelled only against Sahabuddin, Sahanul and Anisul and except them any specific allegation has not been levelled against rest four accused persons except the participating in this alleged occurrence. Further, from perusal of the injury report of victim namely Md. Jaherul and Jabelul it is evident that aforesaid victims have sustained only simple injury and informant has never alleged in written report that accused persons assaulted them with view to take theirs life away. Further, there is land dispute between the both parties and from record it is evident that there is counter case in between the both parties for the same occurrence.

So having considered the above facts and submissions made by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners, the instant anticipatory bail petition is hereby allowed and accordingly it is ordered to release the petitioners namely **1. Md. Sahabuddin, 2. Md. Sahanul, 3. Md. Anisul, 4. Kahinoor Khatoon, 5. Nazma Khatoon, 6. Noor Bahaar Khatoon and 7. Robeda Khatoon** on bail in the case of surrender/arrest within three weeks of this order on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned subject to the condition as mentioned in the section 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S..
