ORDER

An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Gautam Kumar Khandewal, (2) Pawan Kumar Khandewal, (3) Shubham Bhardwaj, (4) Kaushal Kishore Sharma, (5) Piyush Kumar and (6) Preet Khandewal who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Nagar P.S. Case No. 959/2025 for the offences registered U/S 126(2),118(1),115(2),127(2), 303(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. The copy of the same has been duly served to the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State.

The Ld. counsel of the petitioners have submitted that no B.P. or A.B.P. on behalf of the accused petitioners have been filed or moved before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners have no criminal antecedents. The petitioners are quite innocent and they have committed no offence at all. There is not any allegation of assault upon the petitioners and allegations in the F.I.R. are general and omnibus in nature. The petitioners are local men and ready to furnish local and solvent bailers for the court satisfaction, there is no chance of their absconding. Accordingly, prayed to grant bail.

On the other hand, the Ld. Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer of A.B.P. filed on behalf of the above named accused petitioners and submitted that the petitioners have committed the alleged offence under well planned manner. Hence, it is requested to reject the petition of the above named accused petitioners.

The case of the prosecution, in brief, is that on 26.09.2025 at about 02:30 P.M., informant son namely Chintan Jha reached at Darjeeling Family Restaurant, during the same the accused persons came there and forcibly made him sit on the bullet motorcycle and took him to fast food shop and assaulted to him with lathi-danda and sustained injury. Hence, present case.

Heard rival submission of the Ld. counsel on behalf of the accused petitioners and the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State and perused the case diary. From perusal of the same, it transpires that the case has been registered for the offence punishable U/S 126(2),118(1),115(2),127(2),303(2)/3(5) of B.N.S., against the accused persons. The petitioners are not the named accused of FIR except petitioner no. -06. The petitioners have not been arrested from the spot. Although, injury is grievous in nature, but there is no specific allegation against the petitioners.

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Moreover, the petitioners have clean antecedents and nothing has been recovered from their possession. There is no chance of absconding or tampering with the evidence and they are ready to co-operate during investigation and trial.

Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, the present anticipatory bail petition of accused petitioners namely (1) Gautam Kumar Khandewal, (2) Pawan Kumar Khandewal, (3) Shubham Bhardwaj, (4) Kaushal Kishore Sharma, (5) Piyush Kumar and (6) Preet Khandewal are hereby **allowed** and the petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender **within four (4) weeks of this order**, shall be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court.
