ORDER

An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely (1) Bibi Laila Khatoon, who is apprehending her arrest in connection with Azamnagar P.S. Case No. 453/2025 for the offences registered U/S 420, 467, 468, 471/120(B) of IPC. The copy of the same has already been duly served to the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State.

Heard the Ld. counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The Ld. counsel of the petitioner has submitted that earlier, no B.P. or A.B.P. on behalf of the accused petitioner have been filed or moved earlier before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and she has been falsely implicated in this case. That as per all the documents, the date of birth of petitioner as on 04.08.1984. That the petitioner have no any criminal history. That all the allegation as per the report of Madarsa Board of Faquania certificate and also the report of vigilene is fabricated and imaginary. That the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case by the vigilene. The petitioner is local woman and no chance of her absconding. The petitioner is ready to furnish local and solvent bailors to the satisfaction of the court. Accordingly, prayed to grant bail.

On the other hand, the Ld. Addl. P.P. vehemently opposed the prayer of A.B.P. filed on behalf of the above named accused petitioner and submitted that the petitioner has committed the alleged offence under well planned manner. Hence, it is requested to reject the petition of the above named accused petitioner.

The case of the prosecution, in brief, a vigilance inquiry found that Bibi Laila Khatoon allegedly used forged educational certificates to obtain appointment as a Panchayat Teacher. Verification by Bihar State Madarsa Education Board revealed that her actual date of birth was 04.08.1987, but the documents submitted for employment showed 04.08.1984. The certificates were marked "NOT OK" during verification. Hence, the present case.

Heard rival submission of the Ld. counsel on behalf of the accused petitioner and the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State and perused the Case Diary. The present Azamnagar

P.S. Case No. 453/2025 for the offences registered U/S 420, 467, 468, 471/120(B) of IPC. The petitioner is named accused of the FIR and the petitioner has not any criminal antecedent. The accused is a woman and a government teacher. The entire allegation is based on discrepancy in the date of birth, where one record mentions 04.08.1984 and the verification report mentions 04.08.1987. Mere difference in date of birth in educational records does not conclusively establish intentional forgery. There is no chance of absconding or tampering with the evidence by the petitioner and she is ready to co-operate into investigation.

Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, the present anticipatory bail petition of the above named accused petitioner is hereby allowed and the petitioner in the event of her arrest or surrender **within four (4) weeks of this order**, shall be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court.
