ORDER

18.05.2026 This petition for regular bail has been filed on the behalf of the accused namely Suman Singh who is in custody since 30.04.2026 in connection with Amdabad P.S. Case No. 64/2026 instituted U/S- 126(2), 115(20, 118(1), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2)(3), 3(5) of the B.N.S..

Heard the learned counsel Shri Vijay Kumar Jha appearing on the behalf of the petitioner and learned A.P.P. Shri Md. Ajaz Alam appearing on the behalf of the State and perused the lower court record along with case diary.

According to F.I.R., prosecution case in nutshell is that on dated 04.03.2026 at about 05:30 O' clock in evening, informant to this case namely Sanam Kumar was returning after purchasing some articles from general shop and when he arrived near the house of Navin Singh, at that time, accused-petitioner namely Suman Singh and other accused named in F.I.R. started abusing to the informant and told to the informant that he is in collusion with theirs enemy. On protest, all accused persons assaulted to the informant by means of fist and leg and one accused namely Reshabh Singh @ Rikky Singh pelted bricks at the head of informant due to which informant's head got injured and blood started oozing out. Further, accused persons also snatched golden chain worth Rs. 1,00,000/-. When informant's brother Himanshu Kumar Singh came to save then accused persons also assaulted him and one another accused namely Monu Singh pelted bricks at the head of Himanshu Kumar Singh due to which his head got injured. Further, Rajni Devi inflicted lathi upon Himanshu Kumar Singh due to which his finger got injured and blood started oozing out. Further, accused person also gave threatening to kill

to the informant.

On the other side learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated all the grounds taken in the bail petition and has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence at all and he has falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that wife of petitioner namely Rajni Devi has also lodged a case against the informant party for the same alleged occurrence and present case has been lodged by the informant only to save his neck from the case of the petitioner. He has further submitted that other accused has already been granted bail by this learned court vide A.B.P. No. 518/2026. He has further submitted that accused-petitioner has got no bad antecedent and accused-petitioner is in custody since 30.04.2026. Accordingly, prayer has been made to allow the bail petition.

Per contra, learned A.P.P. appearing for the state assisted by the learned counsel appearing for the informant has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both parties at length, perused the entire case record as well as both injury reports. From perusal of the case record, it is evident that there is allegation against the petitioner that he and his other associates assaulted to the informant and his brother but there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Further, injury sustained by informant and his brother has been reported to be simple, caused by hard and blunt substance. While, some other witnesses of the case diary have not supported the allegation of theft as levelled against the petitioner. Further, from record it appears that there is a counter-case between both the parties. Further, accused is in custody since 30.04.2026.

So having consideration the above facts the bail petition is hereby allowed and it is ordered to release the petitioner namely Suman Singh, on bail on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000 with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court.
