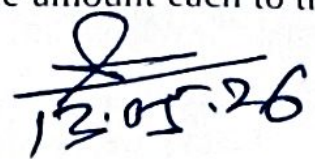

Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, the present anticipatory bail petition of accused petitioner namely (1) Yuvraj Kumar @ Yuvraj Mandal hereby allowed and the petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender **within four (4) weeks of this order**, shall be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court.

ORDER

An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Yuvraj Kumar @ Yuvraj Mandal who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Nagar(Sahayak) P.S. Case No. 317/2026 for the offences registered U/S 126(2), 115(2), 109, 308(2), 352 of B.N.S. The copy of the same has been duly served to the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State.

The Ld. counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no B.P. or A.B.P. on behalf of the accused petitioner has been filed or moved before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner has one criminal antecedents. The petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence at all, The petitioner is brutally beaten by the informant and associate, and he sustained grievous injuries and he is about to death. The petitioner family got admitted the petitioner in Sadar Hospital and requested to issue the requisite to concern police officials to lodge the FIR, but the concerned hospital did not issue the same and referred the petitioner to higher center for the proper treatment. The petitioner is still under treatment and his condition is not better. Petitioner is local man and ready to willing to furnish local and solvent bailors to the satisfaction of this court. Accordingly, prayed to grant bail.

On the other hand, the Ld. Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer of A.B.P. filed on behalf of the above named accused petitioner and submitted that the petitioner has committed the alleged offence under well planned manner. Hence, it is requested to reject the petition of the above named accused petitioner.

The prosecution story according to the FIR in brief is that on 16.03.2026 at about 06:30 P.M. informant Anand Kumar going from his house to the own shop, in the way of the petitioner assaulted him and ran away firing a shot. While fleeing, his bike registration no.BR39AH-2211 was left behind. Hence, the present case.

Heard rival submission of the Ld. counsel on behalf of the accused petitioner and the Ld. Add.P.P. for the State and perused the CD. From perusal of the same, it transpires that the case has been registered for the offence punishable U/S 126(2), 115(2), 109, 308(2), 352 of B.N.S., against the accused person. Though, the petitioner is named accused of FIR, and there is allegation against him that assaulted to informant and fired bullet, but injury report not found. Petitioner was not apprehended at the spot. The petitioner himself sustained injury. Vacant bullet has
