ORDER

An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Nishu, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Amdabad P.S. Case No. 62/2026 for the offences registered U/S 126(2), 115(2), 127(2), 118(1), 109, 307, 324(4), 3(5) of BNS. The copy of the same has been duly served to the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State.

The Ld. counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no B.P. or A.B.P. on behalf of the accused petitioner has been filed or moved before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence at all. That the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Petitioner is ready to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by this court. Petitioner is ready to furnish local and solvent bailors to the satisfaction of the court and there is no chance of his absconding. Accordingly, prayed to grant anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, the Ld. Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer of A.B.P. filed on behalf of the above named accused petitioner and submitted that the petitioner has committed the alleged offence under well planned manner. Hence, it is requested to reject the petition of the above named accused petitioner.

The case of the prosecution, in brief, is that on 03.03.2026 at about 08:00 AM, the informant and his brother were returning home carrying Rs. 2,00,000/- in cash after collecting freight charges. Near Lalbadhani Mor, the accused persons allegedly intercepted them, assaulted them with rods and a knife and caused injuries. During the occurrence, the accused allegedly robbed Rs. 2,00,000/-, attempted to snatch gold ring and damaged the informant's motorcycle and mobile phone and the accused fled from the spot. Hence, the present case.

Heard rival submission of the Ld. counsel on behalf of the accused petitioner and the Ld. Add.P.P. for the State and perused the case diary. From perusal of the same, it transpires that the instant Amdabad P.S. Case No. 62/2026 has been registered U/S 126(2), 115(2), 127(2), 118(1), 109, 307, 324(4), 3(5) of BNS against the accused person. The petitioner is the named accused of the FIR and it is alleged that the petitioner assaulted the informant with an iron rod and a knife, damaged the informant's motorcycle and along with other co-accused committed robbery of Rs. 2,00,000/- by threatening the victims with deadly weapons. There is direct and specific allegation against the petitioner. Charge-sheet has been submitted against (i) Anil Kumar Mandal and (ii) Gorelal, whereas charge-sheet has not been submitted against rest of the accused persons and investigation is still pending.

Hence, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and discussions made hereinabove, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, prayer for bail of the above named accused petitioner stands **rejected**.
