ORDER

1. Arguments have been heard to restore the objection petition under the provisions of Section 34 of The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996/execution, bearing no.ARB-29-19, which was returned to the sole ground of jurisdiction from Bathinda to Faridkot, that too, in consequent to the orders of the **Hon'ble High Court while deciding a bunch of petitions, including CR No. 259 of 2022 (O&M), titled as 'National Highway Authority of India and another Vs. Yashpreet Singh and another', decided on 30.9.2022.**

2. The aforesaid order of the Hon'ble High Court has been modified by the Hon'ble Apex Court vide order dated 29.11.2022 passed in SLP-20804-20809/2022 qua the territorial jurisdiction that the objection petition is maintainable, without influence of the jurisdiction from **Bathinda to Faridkot**, meaning thereby maintainable at Bathinda. As such, the objections are maintainable at Bathinda (with just exceptions), so the present petition is hereby restored against its original number and at the earlier/actual stage. The present civil misc. application stands disposed of.

3. The concerned record be requisitioned with the assistance of learned counsel for the parties from concerned quarter, with liberty to the parties to place on record original documents, if any and the notice to the remaining respondents/parties, if any, be also issued to pursue the respective claims.

Now to come up on 14.07.2023 for the purpose already fixed in the main petition/execution.
