ORDER

10.06.2026 This petition for regular bail has been filed on the behalf of the accused namely Amar Kumar Jha who is in custody since 19.02.2026 in connection with Katihar Nagar P.S. Case No. 24/2026 instituted U/S- 126(2), 115(2), 117(1), 109, 352, 351(2)(3), 3(5) of the B.N.S.

Heard the learned counsel Shri Deo Kumar Jha appearing on the behalf of the petitioners and learned A.P.P. Shri Md. Ajaz Alam appearing on the behalf of the State and perused the lower court record along with case diary.

According to F.I.R., prosecution case in nutshell is that informant to this case namely Sanju Jha lodged a written report before S.H.O. Katihar Nagar to this effect that at present she is working as a teacher in one private school. Informant has further alleged that due to strained relation she is not living with her husband namely Amar Jha (accused-petitioner). Informant has further alleged that her husband used to give threatening to kill her. Further case of the informant is that on dated 05.01.2026 at about 08:00 O'clock she was going to the school and when she reached near Nirman Public School situated at Jha tola Teengachiya at that time accused-petitioner Amar Kumar Jha made lethal attack upon her by the means of rod after that he threw the said rod and fled away. Informant has further stated that due to said assaulting bone of her left hand got fractured and she was referred to higher center for better treatment. Informant has further alleged that by luring her, her husband obtained her land and at present there is no land has been left for her children.

On the other side learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated all the grounds

taken in the bail petition and has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence at all and he has falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that allegation against the petitioner are completely baseless and false. He has further submitted that from F.I.R. it is evident that petitioner has not been living with the informant for about two years. Accused-petitioner has got no bad criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 19.02.2026. Accordingly, prayer has been made to allow the bail petition.

Per contra, learned A.P.P. appearing for the state has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both parties at length, perused the entire case record. From perusal of the case record, it is evident that injury sustained by informant has been reported to be grievous caused by hard and blunt substance but said injury is not on vital part of the body. Furthermore, investigation has already been completed against the accused-petitioner and he is in custody since 19.02.2026 respectively. While prosecution has not made clear as to what purpose will be fulfilled by keeping the petitioner into custody throughout the trial.

So having consideration the above facts as well custody period of the petitioner, the bail petition is hereby allowed and it is ordered to release the petitioner namely Amar Kumar Jha, on bail on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000 with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court, with additional condition that petitioner will file an undertaking with bail bond to this effect that he will remain physically present before Id. Trial court till framing of charge.
