ORDER

09-06-2026- This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on the behalf of accused-petitioners namely Rakhal Singh and Dorai Singh who are apprehending their arrest in connection with aforesaid case.

Heard the ld. counsel Shri Imranul Haque appearing on the behalf of the petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. Shri Md. Ajaz Alam appearing on the behalf of the state.

According to FIR prosecution case in nutshell is that informant to this case namely Punam Devi lodged a written report before SHO Kadwa alleging therein that on dated 07.05.2026 at about 06:00 o'clock in evening her neighbour informed her that accused-petitioners namely Rakhal Singh and Dorai Singh are committing assaulting to her husband namely Manoj Das in the shop of Rakhal Singh. Then she went at the said shop and saw that aforesaid persons were assaulting to her husband. When she want to save her husband then both accused persons assaulted her and with bad intention Rakhal Singh threw her down and tore her blouse and Dorai Singh slapped her and snatched Mangalsutra worth about Rs. 75,000/-. Further, Rakhal Singh pressed the neck of her husband with view to commit his murder. Informant has further alleged that one wheal of tractor belongs to her husband touched new constructed surface of Rakhal Singh's shop due to that very reason such type of occurrence was committed by accused persons. Further, Rakhal Singh took out Rs. 900/- from the pocket of her husband.

On the other side learned counsel for the petitioners has reiterated all the grounds taken in the bail petition and has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and they have committed no offence at all and they have falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that inserted all sections are bailable in nature except section 76, 74, 303(2) of the B.N.S. are not made out

against the petitioners. He has further submitted that the informant and accused-petitioners are residing in same jurisdiction and case has been compromised between both the parties and compromise petition is available on the record. Accused-petitioners have got one criminal history. Accordingly, it has been prayed to allow the said anticipatory bail petition.

Per contra, learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard the both parties at length and perused the entire case record alongwith case dairy. From perusal of the case record it is evident that injury sustained by Punam Devi and Manoj Das have been reported to be simple in nature. Furthermore, harmonious relation has already been restored between the both parties and joint compromise petitionn is also on the record.

So having consideration the above facts and submission made by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners, the instant anticipatory bail petition is hereby allowed and accordingly it is ordered to release the petitioners namely Rakhal Singh and Dorai Singh on bail in the case of surrender/arrest within three weeks of this order on furnishing of bail bond Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned subject to the condition as mentioned in the section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S..
