1. Vide present application a request has been made on behalf of the applicant/ DH for issuance of fresh transfer certificate in respect of the decree dated 07.03.2025.

It is stated that the applicant/ DH had filed the execution petition bearing no. 491/2025 along with an application moved under Section 39 read with Section 151 CPC for transfer of the decree; the transfer certificate along with the requisite documents was issued but the same received back with the remarks insufficient address. execution in accordance with the law.

6. The application is **disposed off** accordingly.
7. One copy of the transfer certificate be given *dasti* to the applicant/ Decree Holder.
8. File be consigned to the **Record Room**, as per rules.
