ORDER

09.06.2026 Aforesaid all three regular bail petitions have been filed on the behalf of the accused namely Raushan Kumar, Prabhat Kumar and Abhimanyu who are in custody since 04.04.2026, 05.04.2026 and 04.04.2026 respectively in connection with Falka P.S. Case No. 61/2026 instituted U/S- 190, 191(2), 191(3), 192, 132, 121(1), 121(2), 126(2), 115(2), 115(2), 109, 285, 287, 324(4), 324(5), 326(f) of the B.N.S. & U/s 4 of Public Property Act. Since aforesaid all three petitions for regular bail have been arising out from same and one Falka P.S. case no. 61/2026, so for the sake of convenience all three bail petitions are being

disposed of by this common order.

Heard the learned counsel Shri Sanjay Kumar Singh and Shri Shrikant Mandal appearing on the behalf of the petitioner and learned A.P.P. Shri Md. Ajaz Alam appearing on the behalf of the State and perused the lower court record along with case diary.

According to F.I.R. prosecution case in nutshell is that informant namely Rahul Kumar Suman lodged a written report before SHO Falka to this effect that on dated 05.04.2026 one person namely Rakesh Kumar Yadav who was accused in Falka P.S, case no. 36/2026 and he had been kept in lock-up of police station, who hung himself and he was taken to Samudaik health centre, Falka and from there he was referred to Sadar Hospital, Katihar for better treatment but in the course of treatment he died. So in the protest some anti-social elements caused hindrance in the moment of transportation as well arson at S.H.-77 and they were damaging the vehicles and some police personnel were brutally assaulted and rifle of the armed forces were also snatched and they also damaged the official vehicles. Informant has further alleged that during the occurrence accused-petitioners namely Raushan Kumar, Prabhat Kumar and Abhimanyu along with some others named accused of F.I.R. were identified.

On the other side learned counsels for the petitioners have reiterated all the grounds taken in the bail petition and have submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence at all. They have further submitted that any specific allegations has not been levelled against the petitioners. Further, while perusal of the video footage of alleged occurrence it is quite clear that petitioners have not been involved in alleged snatching of police rifle. Petitioners have been implicated in this case due to village politics. Moreover, some other accused persons have already been granted regular bail by this court and the case of present petitioners is on similar footing and they are in custody since 04.04.2026, 05.04.2026 and 04.04.2026 respectively. Accordingly, prayer has been made to allow the bail petitions.

Per contra, learned A.P.P. appearing for the state has opposed the prayer for bails.

Heard the both parties at length and perused the entire case record alongwith case dairy. From perusal of the case record it is evident that informant has not made clear as to who identified to the accused-petitioners at the place of occurrence. Further, neither in written application nor any witnesses of case diary have levelled any specific allegation against the aforesaid all three accused-petitioners and as per bail petition petitioners have got no criminal antecedent and they are in custody since 04.04.2026, 05.04.2026 and 04.04.2026 respectively

So having consideration the above facts the all three bail petitions are hereby allowed and it is ordered to release the petitioners namely Raushan Kumar, Prabhat Kumar and Abhimanyu on bail on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000 with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court, with additional condition that the petitioners will file an undertaking with bail bonds that they will remain physically present before the Trial Court till the framing of charge.
