The present application is filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely **(1) Md. Tajmul Haque @ Md. Tajmul**, S/o Ibrahim and **(2) Samsad**, S/o Ajeem, for grant of regular bail in connection with Falka P.S. Case No. 133 of 2026. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 05.06.2026.

It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioners that no regular bail petition or anticipatory bail petition has earlier been filed in this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna prior to this Bail Petition.

The case of prosecution, in brief, is that on 04.06.2026 at about 02:30 PM, the accused persons abused and threatened the informant due to a family dispute and when the informant protested, all the accused persons assaulted the informant and his family members with lathi, danda and sword. Accused Md. Samsad assaulted the informant with a sword on his head, as a result of which informant sustained injury on his head and back. Hence, the present case.

The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case due to family dispute. It is further submitted that both the parties are relatives. It is further submitted that petitioners have no other criminal antecedent and they are in custody since 05.06.2026. In light of these circumstances, Ld. Counsel for the petitioners prayed for release of petitioners.

The Ld. Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioners, but conceded that the matter has been compromised between both the parties.

On call, the informant and other injured persons appeared before the court and stated that the matter has been compromised between both the parties.

After considering the arguments and perusing the records, it appears that there is allegation of assault to the informant and his family members against the petitioners. As per injury report, injuries sustained by the injured persons are simple in nature. On further perusal of record, it appears that the dispute has been settled between both the parties, and a copy of joint compromise petition has also been filed in this case. The informant and other injured persons appeared before the court and stated that they have no objection, if the petitioners are released on bail. As per Para-18 of case diary, petitioners have no other criminal antecedent. Petitioners are in judicial custody since 05.06.2026 and they are ready to cooperate during course of investigation and trial.

In view of the above facts, the prayer of bail of the petitioners is hereby **allowed** and they are directed to be released on bail on furnishing the bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below.
