**ORDER**

**10.04.2026-** This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioner namely Sanjeev Kumar Sharma who is apprehending his arrest in connection with aforesaid case.

Heard the Ld. counsel Shri Rajib Ranjan Jaiswal appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. Shri Md. Azaj Alam on behalf of the state.

According to complaint petition prosecution case in nutshell is that marriage of Complainant namely Deepa Kumari was solemnised with Sanjeev Kumar Sharma on 03.05.2022 and at the time of said marriage people of her maika gave ornaments of gold and silver, Rs. 2,00,000/- in cash and other articles to the Complainant as gift. After that with all said articles Complainant went her in-law's house and started living there happily but later on accused-petitioner and other accused named in F.I.R. started committing physical and mental torture to the Complainant and started demanding Rs. 5,00,000/- in dowry. Later on panchayati was convened but accused person did not pay heed. Later on Complainant got pregnant and in said condition accused persons brutally assaulted to the Complainant and got her ousted and told that until and unless said demand is fulfilled they will not permit her to leave in matrimonial house.

Per contra Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this false and fabricated case. Complainant has also filed Maintenance Case no. 180/24 against the petitioner before Principal Family Judge, Katihar. Moreover there is no specific allegation against the petitioner and there is no medical prescription on record regarding the physical assault of the Complainant and petitioner has got no bad criminal antecedent.

Per contra, Learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard both the parties and perused the case record. From perusal of the case record it is evident that, it is evident that Complainant has neither levelled any specific allegation in complaint petition nor in her S.A. against the petitioner.

Further there is medical slip on record but same is not legible. Moreover it prima facie appears that due to strained relation in between Complainant and petitioner this case has been brought into existence.

So having considered the above facts and submissions made by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner, the instant anticipatory bail petition is hereby allowed and accordingly it is ordered to release the petitioner namely **Sanjeev Kumar Sharma** on bail in the case of surrender/arrest within three weeks of this order on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned subject to the condition as mentioned in the section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.
