25.05.2026: A petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely Sunaina Devi, under Order IX Rule 4 read with Section 151 of the CPC, 1908 for restoration of Succession certificate case no. 03 of 2021.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the aforesaid Succession Certificate case was pending for filing of court fees and the petitioner, namely Sunaina Devi, was actively pursuing the matter. However, due to the sickness of the said petitioner, the case remained unattended and could not be properly pursued, as a result of which the case came to be dismissed for non-prosecution. It is further submitted that the petitioners are now ready to contest and prosecute the case and, therefore, prayer has been made for restoration of the said Succession certificate case. Perusal of the record shows that the case was earlier dismissed due to non-prosecution. Considering the submissions made on behalf of the petitioners and the circumstances explained regarding the sickness of petitioner Sunaina Devi, this Court is of the view that sufficient cause has been shown for restoration of the case. Accordingly, the petition is allowed on payment of cost of Rs. 2500/- to be deposited in the Victim Compensation Scheme within a period of four weeks from today, failing which this order shall stand automatically vacated and the restoration petition shall be deemed to have been rejected.

3. Upon deposit of the said cost within the stipulated period, Succession certificate Case No. 3 of 2021 shall stand restored to its original file and number.
