	24.03.2026	1. This is the anticipatory bail application U/s – 482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused persons namely 1. Md. Tarik Hussain aged about 37 years S/o- Jakir Hussain R/o Vill-Ekhatha, P.S.- Khutauna, District- Madhubani in connection with CR.No.-209/2025 U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 85,303(2), 82(1), 352 of BNS. 2. Heard Sri Rishi Kumar Jha for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. It has further been submitted that no criminal case has been lodged against the petitioners. It has further been stated that petitioner never tortured the complainant nor demanded any kind of dowry. It has further stated that complainant do not want to live with her husband. It was also submitted that the petitioner is local man and there is no chance of his absconding, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The Prosecution case on 06.05.2025 stating therein that the complainant was married with Md. Tarik Hussain as per Muslim custom Dan Mohar Rs. 35551/- on 19.06.2014 and went to her Sasural the parents gifted her cash Rs. 02 Lakhs and other articles worth Rs. 3 Lakhs and the complainant started residing there happily and in the year 2015 gave a birth of son Hamdan Ahmad. In the year 2018 all three accused persons named in complaint petition started demanded cash of Rs. 02 Lakh to bring from his parents as dowry and on refusal they started torture, assault and stopped giving food to the complainant. It has further been said that the husband of the complainant was working in a factory in Assam where in the year 2019 he performed second marriage with another girl and the same was	

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	cont. 24.03.2026	known in Dec 2022 and on panchayat the husband of the complainant accepted regarding the same and have two children from second marriage and promise to keep complainant with full dignity and regard. It has further been stated that on 25.02.2023 at about 10 PM all the accused persons demanded dowry cash Rs. 02 Lakh to bring from her parents and on refusal they assaulted to the complainant and tried to set fire. On noise many persons reached there and saved the complainant. Thereafter the accused persons ousted the complainant from the house, thereafter is residing at parental place. 6. Perused the case record. From perusal of the case record, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record, I find that both parties are agreed to live together. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners namely Md. Tarik Hussain , is hereby provisionally allowed for three months and after then the Ld. Trial Court will confirm the bail after due satisfaction. In the event of arrest/surrender by the petitioner within 21 days of the receipt/production of the order, they are directed to be released on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned with an undertaking under section 482(2) of BNSS.
