	15.06.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely 1. Shravan Sahu, 2. Ghuran Sahu, 3. Babita Devi & 4. Nibha Devi seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Jhanjharpur R.S. P.S case No- 26/2025, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 75, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS. 2. Heard Sri Pradeep Kumar on behalf of petitioners and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. counsel Sri Pradeep Kumar on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that earlier no any bail petition has been filed before this Court or before Hon'ble Court Patna and petitioners have no any criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed any offence and they have been falsely implicated in this false case due to grudge, malice, dirty party politics of village and land dispute and no occurrence alleged has ever taken place. It is also submitted that there is a case and counter case in between the parties and alleged all sections are bailable in nature except U/s 110, 76 & 117(1), which are added only to make the offence graver. It is also submitted that the case has been compromised in between the parties. Lastly it is submitted that petitioners are apprehending their arrest in this case, and Ld. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the petition and prayed

The prosecution story in brief is that, informant of this case is Kaushalya Devi, she has alleged that on 19.03.2025 at 08:30 PM, due to previous enmity and land dispute all the accused persons named in FIR including these petitioners, armed with deadly weapons, entered into her house and started abusing her, on protest they molested her daughter-in-law, when her husband and son came to rescue, Ghuran Sahu and Shravan Sahu assaulted them by means of iron rod with intention to kill, resulted they became injured and accused Ghuran Sahu snatched golden mangalsutra from her neck and Sharvan Sahu snatched Rs. 1700/- from the pocket of her son. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at length on this instant anticipatory bail petition and perused the case record along with LCR including case dairy and injury report available. From perusal of the record it transpires that on the basis of application given by informant namely Kaushalya Devi before SHO Jhanjharpur R.S. P.S., this very case has been registered U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 75, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS, against the petitioners and others. From perusal as per allegation alleged in the FIR it is alleged that accused persons assaulted to the informant's husband, son and daughter-in-law by means of iron rod with intention to kill and also snatched mangalsutra from her neck and Sharvan Sahu snatched Rs. 1700/- from the pocket of her son. From perusal of the record it also transpires that there is a land dispute and case and counter in between the	
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Contd. 15.06.2026	parties and from perusal of the injury report, it transpires that no external injury was found. Moreover, this case has been compromised in between the parties and a joint compromise petition, bearing signature of both the parties, dully verified by their advocates, is also annexed with the bail petition and informant is also present before the court and she conceded that she has no objection, if the petitioners be enlarged on bail. From perusal of para no. 03 of the bail petition, it also transpires that petitioners have no any criminal antecedent. 7. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances discussed above as well as clean antecedent of petitioners, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail accordingly, petitioners namely, 1. Shravan Sahu, 2. Ghuran Sahu, 3. Babita Devi & 4. Nibha Devi, are directed to be enlarged on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before Ld. Court below, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Court below, as condition laid u/s 482 of BNSS.
