This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 11.5.2026 in connection with Khaira P.S.Case No.188/2026 registered for the offence U/s.126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 117(2), 74, 329(4), 351(2), and 352 read with 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of the C.J.M.,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Paras Kumar,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Asmina khatoon has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Khaira Police Station alleging therein that on 10.5.2026 at 8 a.m., when the informant was cooking meal in her house, then at the same time, three accused persons including the petitioner came there having lashed with iron rod, and the petitioner struck on the head of the informant, and thereafter all the accused persons started throwing bricks and stones which damages the house of the informant,and when the sister of the informant came for rescue of the informant, then she was also assaulted by the accused persons.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner has clean antecedent. It is further submitted that both the parties have amicably settled their dispute by way of written compromise which is part of the record. It is also submitted that some co-accused persons have been granted regular bail by the learned court below on the basis of said compromise.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail but conceded the factum of compromise between the parties.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and

further considering the particular fact that there is case and counter case between the parties, and both the parties have amicably settled their dispute by way of written compromise. Moreover, the petitioner has clean antecedent.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
