ORDER

This regular bail petition has been filed under section 483 B.N.S.S. on behalf of the petitioners **Nibhesh Kumar, Anand Kumar & Indal Kamat** who have been arrested in connection with **Khutauna PS Case No.11/2026, GR No.96/2026 under section 126(2), 309(6). 317(3), 3(5) of the B.N.S.** which is pending in the court of Md. S. Rahman, J.M. 1st Class, Jhanjharpur is being pressed and heard.

The prosecution case in brief is that on 14.01.2026 in the evening, informant has gone to his home from Khutauna market by motorcycle. At about 8:25 PM, he reached the paved road in front of Greed Field Public School on Got Khutauna Jaynagar Road, where Bibhash Kumar, Nibhas Kumar, and other persons surrounded him with bamboo sticks in their hands, and started demanding extortion of Rs. 50,000/- from him. When he denied to pay the extortion money, Bibhash Kumar snatched his purse, and his friend started beating informant mercilessly with bamboo sticks. When informant shouted, then people came from nearby areas, then accused persons ran away. Informant had Rs. 8500/- in his purse. They snatched his purse, and ran towards Got Khutauna Gachhi.

Learned counsel for the accused petitioners submits that the accused petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence and they have no criminal antecedent. No occurrence as alleged by the prosecution has taken place and petitioners have been implicated in this case falsely due to personal grudge, malice, spite and dirty village party politics. The total case story is false and concocted. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 16.01.2026 and accordingly it has been prayed to grant bail to the accused petitioners.

The learned APP had opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard the argument and perused the case record. That the petitioners do not bear any criminal antecedent. Injury sustained by injured is simple in nature. Petitioners are in custody since 16.01.26, which is about three months. Investigation has been completed, and there is no chance of interference in investigation. Considering these facts, this Court is inclined to enlarge petitioners on bail. Petitioners namely **1. Nibhash Kumar, 2. Anand Kumar and 3. Indal Kamat** are ordered to be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- along with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court.
