Govind Kumar Jha @ Govind Jha, 3. Indal Jha @ Indra Narayan Jha,</b> who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Madhepur P.S case No- 04/2026, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 118(2), 109(1), 76, 331(5), 351(2), 351(3), 305, 352, 3(5), 49 of the BNS.</li><li>2. Heard Sri Parshu Ram Mishra Ld. Advocate, on behalf of petitioners and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state.</li><li>3. Ld. counsel of the petitioners has submitted that earlier no any bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners either before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna and petitioners have no any criminal antecedent and are quite innocent and have not committed any offence. It is further submitted that petitioners have falsely been implicated in this false case, due to dirty village party politics and enmity and prosecution story is totally false and concocted and no occurrence did ever took place. It is also submitted that alleged all sections are bailable except U/s 118(1), 109(1), 76, 303(2), 331(5) of the BNS, which is introduced to make out non-bailable offence, which is not made out against the petitioners and there is no any specific allegation against the petitioners. It is also submitted that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners and case has been compromised in between the parties. Ld. Counsel prays to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail.</li><li>4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.</li></ol>

The prosecution story in brief is that informant of this case is Vimal Devi, she has alleged that on 08.01.2026 at 09:45 PM, she was sleeping with her husband, in the meantime all the accused persons named in FIR armed with deadly weapons, came on motorcycle by using abusing language and when she opened the door Manish Kumar Jha and Govind Kumar Jha have molested her and pulled her saree, resulted she became naked and on shouting, her husband namely Birju Thakur came then Manish Kumar Jha and Govind Kumar Jha assaulted him by means of knife, resulted he became injured and accused persons also threatened for dire consequences and they took hasiya, khurpi, dabiya worth Rs. 1000/- and also took Rs. 900/- from steel box. Hence, this case.</p> <p>6. Heard both side at length and perused the case record along with case diary and injury report. From perusal it transpires that, on the basis of written application given by the informant namely Vimal Devi before SHO Madhepur P.S, this very case has been registered U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 118(2), 109(1), 76, 331(5), 351(2), 351(3), 305, 352, 3(5), 49 of the BNS against the petitioners accused. took Rs. 900/- from steel box.

From perusal it also transpires the matter has been compromised in between the parties and a joint compromise petition bearing signature of both the parties dully verified by their advocates, is annexed with this bail petition. From perusal of the injury report it transpires that nature of injury is simple. Apart from that petitioners have no any criminal antecedent.

7. Therefore, considering aforesaid facts as well as good relation has been restored in between the parties, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail, accordingly, petitioners namely, **1. Manish Kumar Jha @ Golu Jha, 2. Govind Kumar Jha @ Govind Jha, 3. Indal Jha @ Indra Narayan Jha**, are directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within a period of 21 days from receipt of this order, be enlarged on bail, on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties** of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Court below, as conditions laid u/s 482 of the BNSS.
