This is the anticipatory bail application U/s –482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused persons namely Devendra Pandit S/o – Dasrath Pandit, aged about 45 years, resident of Vill.- Nighma, P.S- Ghoghardiha Dist- Madhubani in connection with Phulparas P.S case No- 25/2023 Gr.No.-85/2023, U/s- 392,511 of IPC. 2. Heard Sri Sanjay Kumar Sinha for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It has further been stated that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It was also submitted that the petitioner is local man and there is no chance of his absconding, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that informant Raju Giri alleged that on the date and time of occurrence when informant went towards Phulparas from Jhanjharpur and when he reached near Demotel, then three persons came on Pulasar Motorcycle and hit by foot informant and due to which informant fell down. Then one person injured him by gun butt and other two person took Rupees five thousand from the pocket of the informant. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to commit robbery of Rs. Five thousand on road. The witnesses have supported the prosecution case in para 1 and 6 of case diary and investigation is going on.
