ORDER

This regular bail petition has been filed under section 483 B.N.S.S. on behalf of the petitioner **Shivdutt Mukhiya @ Shidat Mukhiya** who has been arrested in connection with **Laukaha PS Case No.66/2025, GR No.237/2025 under section 305, 317(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S.** which is pending in the court of SDJM, Jhanjharpur is being pressed and heard.

According to the FIR, the prosecution case in nutshell is that on 27.04.2025 at about 02:00 PM, the thieves entered in her house from the roof of her house, and stolen the jewellery and Rs. 50,000 cash. The thieves put those articles in the pocket, and ran away. On checking the CCTV camera installed in the house, it was found that Dipesh Kumar Yadav has committed the crime. Information was received that Surendra yadav, Mukesh Kumar Yadav, Shivdutt Mukhiya, and Dipesh Kumar Yadav had committed the crime. Hence, this case.

Learned counsel for the accused petitioner submits that the accused petitioner is innocent, and has not committed any offence. He has one criminal antecedent. No occurrence as alleged by the prosecution

has taken place, and petitioner has been implicated in this case falsely due to personal grudge, malice, spite, and dirty village party politics. The total case story is false and concocted. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 04.05.2025, and accordingly it has been prayed to grant bail to the accused petitioner.

The learned had APP opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard the argument, and perused the record. Petitioner is in custody since 04.05.25, which is about one year. Petitioner had one criminal antecedent. Other co accused has been already granted bail by Hon'ble High Court in Cr. Misc-61594 of 2025. Petitioner was not captured in the CCTV footage of the occurrence. Charge sheet has been submitted, and there is no apprehension in interference of investigation. Considering these facts, this Court is inclined to grant bail to petitioner namely **Shivdutt Mukhiya @ Shidat Mukhiya**. He is directed to be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld Trial Court.
