Dileep Kumar Pandit @ Vinay Kumar, seeking pre-arrest bail, in connection with Phulparas P.S case No- 187/2025, U/s- 329(3), 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 74, 303(2), 351(3), 3(5) of the BNS.2. Heard Smt. Ranjeeta Kumari, Ld. Advocate, on behalf of petitioners and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state.3. Ld. counsel of the petitioners has submitted that earlier no other bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners, either before this Court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna. That the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that the prosecution story is false, and concocted. The instant case is a counter blast of Phulparas P.S. Case No. 201/25, and only to make pressure, petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner No. 01 is a lady, and petitioner No. 02 is a student. Ld. Counsel had prayed to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail.4. The learned APP present on behalf of state had opposed the bail petition, and prayed to reject it.5. The prosecution story in brief is that informant of this case is Bal Ram Pandit. On 28.04.2025 at about 06:30 A.M., when informant was going for natural call, Dilip Kumar Pandit started abusing him. After that all the accused persons named in FIR including these petitioners, came at the doorstep of informant, armed with lathi, danda, sword, farsa etc and assaulted the informant. Dilip Kumar assaulted by means of sword with intention to kill him, which resulted in head injury. Pramod Narayan Pandit assaulted by means of farsa, and when his mother came to save, accused persons also assaulted her, and snatched gold mangalsutra. Hence, this case.6. Perused the case diary. Petitioners bear one criminal antecedent, in which they are on bail. Perusal of fardbyan shows that the fight broke out on trivial matter. From FIR of Phulparas P.S. Case No. 201/25, it is quite clear that both sides have enmical relation. From para-24 of case diary, allegation of theft has been found incorrect as per investigation by police. Injury sustained by injured is simple in nature.

It is hereby ordered that in the event of surrender or arrest before the Court below/concerned police within 30 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/police subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) BNSS.
