This anticipatory bail petition filed under section 482 B.N.S.S. on behalf of the above named petitioner **Ashish Kumar**, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Narhaiya P.S. Case No. 106/2025** for the offence **under section 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 329(4), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. & 27 Arms Act**, which is pending in the court of Md. Nafees Kamran, J.M.F.C, Jhanjharpur is being pressed and heard.

The prosecution case in brief is that on 24 11.2025 at about 08:00 PM, Informant's wife Veena Devi and he were running their grocery shop located in their house. In the evening at about 17:00 PM, two boys 1. Satyam Kumar Angad, 2. Mukesh Kumar, came to his shop, and asked for cigarettes, and the price. Informant told them Rs.7 per cigarette, on which both of them said that he will pay Rs 6 per cigarette. When the informant told them about the loss, they abused the informant, and his wife. They threatened them with dire consequences. They left from there, and a short while later, around 06:00 PM, Satyam Kumar @ Angad, came to his shop with a pistol in his hand, along with co-accused persons, and about 8 unidentified persons. They started abusing informant and his wife, dragged the informant out of the shop, and began kicking and punching the informant. Satyam Kumar Angad, fired a shot in the air with his pistol, intending to kill the informant, in which he narrowly escaped.

The attackers took a chain weight about 3 bhar from informant's wife's neck. Hearing the gunshots, people from the neighborhood began to approach. Seeing the approaching crowd, the perpetrators fled from the informant shop. When informant informed Narhiya, P.S., about this incident, the patrolling police came, inquired, and recovered a fired pistol bullet shell from the spot. Hence, this case.

Learned Counsel of the petitioner accused has submitted that no any bail petition has been filed earlier in any Court, or in Hon'ble Patna High Court, Patna. It is further submitted that the petitioner accused is quite innocent, has committed no offense, and no occurrence as alleged has taken place. The prosecution story is totally false, absurd, and concocted. That the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to personal grudge, malice, and dirty village party politics. That the petitioner accused has no criminal antecedents. Accordingly, it has been prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the accused petitioner.

The learned APP had opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both side at length and perused the case diary. Petitioner do not bear any criminal antecedent. From perusal it transpires that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. That the co accused who had fired has been granted bail. Injury sustained by injured are simple in nature, caused by hard and blunt substance. Other co accused Bittu Kumar has been granted regular bail, in which informant and victim, had appeared in the Court, and had supported the factum of compromise. Considering the aforesaid facts as well as discussion made above, the Anticipatory Bail Petition of the petitioner accused namely **Ashish Kumar** is hereby **allowed**. It is hereby ordered that in the event of surrender or arrest before the court below/concerned police within 30 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/police subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) BNSS.
