Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Shatrudhan Kumar Yadav @ Shatrudhan Yadav, aged about 19 years S/o- Haribansh Yadav, R/o Village- Narar Dhatta Tole, PS.- Kaluahi , District Madhubani, in connection with Bhairabasthan P.S case No-159/2025 Gr.No.-2192/2025, U/s- 309(4) of BNS. 2. Heard Sri Hira Lal Yadav, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri D.S. Jha learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed on behalf of this petitioner before this court or any superior court. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has also been submitted that the petitioner has two criminal antecedents. He has further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 15.12.2025. It has further been stated that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. 4. The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on 25.11.2025 at 6:10 PM four unknown motorcycle riders committed the robbery of the motorcycle, Identity Card and Mobile of informant and threatened him to kill. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to commit robbery of motorcycle and mobile of the informant. On further perusal I find that witnesses have supported the prosecution case in para 2,3,4 of case diary and investigation is going on. Further the petitioner has two criminal antecedent. 7.
