	09.06.2026	1. This is the anticipatory bail application U/s – 482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused person namely 1. Lalit Yadav aged about 35 years S/o- Late Domi Yadav 2. Manoj Kumar Yadav aged about 32 years S/o- Parmeshwar Yadav Both R/o Village- Konar, P.S- Phulparas, Dist.- Madhubani in connection with Phulparas P.S Case No- 267/2023 Gr.No.- 859/2023, U/s- 341,323,307,354(B),379,504,506/34 of IPC. 2. Heard Sri Ashutosh Kumar for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It has further been stated that there is land dispute in between the parties. It was also submitted that the petitioner is local man and there is no chance of his absconding, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on 15.05.2023 at about 3 PM petitioners started dispute on Khata No. 23 old and kheshra No. 360 and Jamabandi No. 319 measuring 1 katha 3 dhur which is land in the name of late Bathu Yadav in spite of that petitioner Binod started dispute unnecessary and petitioners alongwith other accused assaulted informant. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to assault informant. On further perusal I find that witnesses have supported the prosecution case in para 2,6,7 of case diary and investigation is going on. The injury report is still awaited.

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7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely 1. Lalit Yadav and 2. Manoj Kumar Yadav is hereby disposed with direction to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within fifteen days and Ld. Trial Court will pass order on merit on the basis of totality of facts and without being prejudiced of this order.
