	06.05.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely 1. Asha Devi, 2. Visho Sah seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Jhanjharpur P.S. Case No. 35/2026, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 74, 352, 3(5) of the BNS. 2. Heard Sri Raghvendra Yadav, Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioners and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned A.P.P. for the state. 3. Ld. counsel of the petitioners have submitted that, earlier no other bail petition has been filed in this Court or Hon'ble High Court Patna and petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioners have been implicated in this case on the basis of suspicion and applicant No.2 Visho Sah is 70 years old and cannot walk properly. It is also submitted that first applicant is women and a false allegation is leveled against her. Lastly it is submitted that petitioners are apprehending their arrest in this case, and Id. Counsel prays to allow the petitioners on anticipatory bail. 4. The learned A.P.P Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The case of the prosecution in brief is that, the informant of this case is Bindeshwar Sahu and he has alleged that on 24.02.2026 at around 11 A.M. due to some dispute related to spitting, the informant's younger brother's wife started abusing and when informant's daughter in law protested then she hit with brick due to which informant's daughter in law sustained head injury. Visho Sah attacked informant with khanti due to which he sustained injury on head and Shravan Sahu assaulted the wife of the informant, dragged her and make her naked. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both side at length and perused the case record along with case diary and the injury report of the injured persons. From perusal of the record it transpires that, on the basis of written application presented by	

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Contd. 06.05.2026	the informant namely Bindeshwar Sahu before SHO Jhanjharpur, this very case has been registered U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 74, 352, 3(5) of the BNS. Against the petitioners and others From perusal of the record it transpires that there is a case and counter case in between the parties and petitioner No. 1 is a lady aged about 37 years and other accused i.e. petitioner No. 2 is concerned, who is aged about 70 years and petitioners have no any criminal antecedent ever before. From perusal of the injury report, it transpires that injuries of the victim namely Miss Julee Devi and Mr. Bideshwar Sah are found simple in nature caused by blunt object. 7. Therefore, considering the facts and circumstances discussed above as well as clean antecedent of the petitioners accused and injury found in simple in nature. Therefore, considering the aforementioned facts, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail accordingly, petitioners namely, 1. Asha Devi, 2. Visho Sah, are directed to be enlarged on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within a period of 21 days from receipt of this order, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld.
