	20.05.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely 1. Ghuran Das, 2. Ravindra Kumar Das @ Bauku Das who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Andhrathari P.S case No- 180/2025, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS. 2. Heard Sri Nitish Kumar Thakur, Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioners and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. counsel Sri Nitish Kumar Thakur on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that earlier no any bail petition has been filed before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court Patna and petitioners have no any criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed any offence and have falsely been implicated in this case due to land dispute and dirty village party politics. It is further submitted that no occurrence as alleged did ever took place and prosecution story is totally false, vague and concocted and there is no specific allegation against the petitioners and alleged all sections are bailable except U/s 109, 303(2) of the BNS, which are introduced only to make the case non bailable. It is also submitted that allegation against these petitioners are simple, general and omnibus and no incriminating article has been	

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Contd..... 20.05.2026	recovered from the possession of the petitioners. Lastly it is submitted that petitioners are apprehending their arrest in this case, and Id. Counsel prays to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution story in brief is that informant of this case is Ramvilash Das. He has alleged that on 02.12.2025 at about 06:00 AM, due to land dispute all the accused persons named in FIR including these petitioners, assaulted over his head with intention to kill by means of farsa, kudal, resulted he got injured and they also snatched golden chain and Rs. 20,000/-. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at the length and perused the case record along with case diary including injury report of injured person. From perusal it transpires that on the basis of written application given by the informant victim namely Ramvilash Das before SHO Andhrathari P.S., this very case has been registered U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS. From perusal of the record it also transpires that as per allegation alleged in the FIR, there is a land dispute in between the parties and it is alleged that on the date and time of occurrence, accused petitioners assaulted to the informant victim with intention to kill by means of farsa, kudal, resulted he sustained injury. But from perusal of the injury report it	
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transpires that injury is simple in nature and petitioners have no any criminal antecedent ever before. Apart from that it also appears that FIR has been lodged with a delay of five days.

7. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances discussed above as well as land dispute in between the parties and injury found simple in nature and delay in lodging the FIR, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. Hence, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within a period of 21 days from receipt of this order, petitioners namely **1. Ghuran Das, 2. Ravindra Kumar Das @ Bauku Das** be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties** of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Court below, as condition laid u/s 482 of BNSS.
