	28.04.2026	- Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Mangnu Singh, S/o- Dinesh Singh, aged about- 45 years R/o Village- Ahmhi, P.S- Ghoghardiha, District Madhubani, in connection with Ghoghardiha P.S Case No- 33/2026, Gr.No.- 393/2026, U/s- 115(2), 126(2), 74, 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS - Heard Sri Lakshmi Kant Singh learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha learned APP for the state. - The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no other regular bail petition has been filed earlier on behalf of the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further submitted that the informant is not eye witness in this case. It has further submitted that the victim Raushan Khatoon died Patna and the family members not instituted F.I.R. in Patna and hence this false case. It has further submitted that the police came village-Amahi and caught victim and took to PS Ghoghardiha dated 25.02.2026 and not instituted F.I.R. and was released on bond with her husband from police station. He has further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 04.03.2026. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. - The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. - The prosecution case according to Informant is that on 25.02.2026 at 09:00 AM, Bhabhi of informant Raustam Khatoon went at door of Headman Kumari Devi to give application meantime Mangnu Singh, Mahendra Singh, Santosh Singh, Sita Devi, Sangita Devi, Babita Devi, Ajay Singh, Vijay Singh, Shyam Singh, Shambhu Singh, Ramesh Singh, Anita Devi, Nur Singh @ Ranjit, Rambharosh Singh, Vakil Singh, Ansu Devi, Runa Devi and others 5 person assaulted from Iron Rod, Lathi and leashed from rop and called on police by dialling 112 and later on during treatment she died at Patna. - Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to assault victim Roushan Khatoon alongwith other co accused who succumbed to her injuries at hospital. On further perusal I find that for the alleged occurrence	

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	cont. 28.04.2026	dated 25.02.2026 at 9AM, Ghoghardiha PS case no.-83/2026 was registered on 28.02.2026, on written application of informant Md. Rustam. On further perusal of Station Dairy Sanha dated 25.02.2026 from 11:30 to 16:00, I find that the victim Roushan Khatoon and her husband Sahabuddin were realeased on P.R. bond from Ghoghardiha P.S confessing their guilt and no complaint of any type of assault or injury was made before the police at the time of release on PR from Ghoghardiha PS and Police also did not sent the victim Roushan Khatoon at any Hospital for treatment and no case was registered and hence it appears that F.I.R. has been registered on 28.02.2026 after due thought. It is pertinent to mention heare that accused had called Police on doing misbehavior with Mukhiya. The opinion regarding cause of death is reserved. On further perusal I find that petitioner is in custody since 04.03.2026 and there is no specific allegation against the petitioner and the allegation is of general nature. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and keeping in view the period of custody and facts recorded in Station Diary Sanha and delayed FIR, the petitioner Mangnu singh is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, with an undertaking under section 437 (3) of Cr.P.C, to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned and with further condition that the petitioner will co-operate in investigation and will not influence the witnesses in any manner.
