This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely Ram Prakash Yadav @ Kari Yadav , seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Bheja P.S case No- 106/2023, U/s- 341, 323, 324 , 307, 379, 504, 506, 34 of IPC. 2. Heard Sri Shambhunath Jha Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioner and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. counsel of the petitioner has submitted that earlier no other bail petition has been filed on behalf of this petitioner either before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court Patna and petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and petitioner has falsely been implicated in this false case due to dirty village party politics and prosecution story is totally false and concocted and allegation against this petitioner is general and omnibus. It is also submitted that there is land dispute in between the parties. Lastly it is submitted that petitioner is apprehending his arrest in this case, and ld. Counsel prays to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that, the informant of this case is	

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Contd.... 05.05.2026	Kushma Devi and she has filed a written an application before SHO Bheja, stating there in that on 14.11.2023 at about 02 P.M. all the accused persons named in F.I.R. including this petitioner, armed with lathi, danda, iron rod came at the house of informant and on the order of Jagdish Yadav all the accused persons started assaulting the informant, her son and her nephew Ramsewak Mandal, due to which Ramsewak Mandal got head injury and Kari Yadav snatched silver Hasulli from the neck of informant. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at length and perused the case record along with LCR including case diary. From perusal of the record, it transpires that on the basis of written application given by the informant namely Kushma Devi before SHO Khutana, this very case has been registered U/s- 341, 323, 324 , 307, 379, 504, 506, 34 of the IPC against the petitioner and others. From perusal it transpires that there is specific allegation against the petitioner is that he has snatched a silver hasuli weight of 400 gram from the neck of the informant but no any kind of recovery has been made from the possession of the petitioner and there is no any specific allegation of assault against the petitioner. Apart from that some other co-

Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as omnibus and general allegation, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail accordingly, petitioner namely, Ram Prakash Yadav @ Kari Yadav, is directed to be enlarged on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within a period of 21 days from receipt of this order, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld.
