ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the above named petitioners **1. Ramavtar Sah, 2.Ramesh Sah, 3. Prakash Kumar Sah & 4. Anjala Devi**, who are apprehending his arrest in connection with **Laukahi P.S Case No.-20/2026** for the offence **under section 191(2), 191(3), 115(2), 126(2), 118(1), 121(1), 121(2), 132, 324(4), 352, 351(2) of B.N.S** which is pending in the court of Md. N. Kamran, JMFC, Jhanjharpur is being pressed and heard.

The case of the prosecution in nutshell is that on 13.02.2026 at about 14:15, informant along with police official, went to accused house namely Prakash. He saw three persons were standing near Prakash's house, and after seeing the police one person ran away towards the house. Chaukidar confirmed that, the fled man was Prakash Sah. When police official tried to enter the house, then other two persons started misbehaving, and abusing. Accused namely Umesh Sah grabbed the collar of the informant, and started pulling him. Then with the help of other police officials Prakash Sah and Umesh Sah were caught. After that villagers started obstructing in the work of police officials whose name were verified by the Chaukidar, and named in F.I.R. With the help of that villagers Prakash Sah managed to escape from there. In

the meantime accused namely Vishwanath Sah, Sujit Kumar, and Radhe Kumar, started stone pelting on the police vehicle and police officials. After that police official caught Sujit Kumar and Radhe Kumar. Then official got information that Vishwanath Sah and Umesh sah were seen in Laukahi. Then police reached there, and caught Umesh Sah. Vishwanath Sah managed to escape from there. Hence, this case.

Learned counsel for the accused petitioners submitted that the petitioner no. 1 & 3 has one criminal antecedent, and rest have no criminal antecedents and are quite innocent and have not committed any offence whatsoever. That no other regular or anticipatory bail petition is pending before your hon'ble Court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna. That the petitioners are not involved in this occurrence. It is further stated that all the sections are bailable except 118(1), 121(1), 121(2), 132 of B.N.S, which was introduced only to make offences graver. It is also stated that petitioners are falsely implicated in this false case due to dirty village, politics. The petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. Accordingly, it has been prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.

Learned APP had opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Heard the argument and perused the case diary. It is apparent from the case diary that petitioners name had surfaced in the occurrence, on the basis of identification done by chowkidar. But the said chowkidar statement has not been recorded by the I.O of the case. Allegation against the petitioners are not specific, rather general and omnibus in nature. Considering the aforesaid facts and discussions made above. The petitioners accused namely **1. Ramavtar Sah, 2.Ramesh Sah, 3. Prakash Kumar Sah & 4. Anjila Devi is allowed.** In the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within 15 days from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS.
