Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Amlesh Yadav, S/o- Deo Krishan Yadav, aged about- 35 years R/o Village- Nabtol, P.S- Phulparas, District Madhubani, in connection with Phulparas P.S Case No-407/2021, Gr.No.-1728/2021, U/s- 147, 148, 149, 448, 504, 379, 506 of IPC 2. Heard Sri Nageshwar Yadav learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no other regular bail petition has been filed earlier on behalf of the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further submitted that petitioner has three criminal history. He has further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 12.08.2025. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. 4. The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case according to Informant is that on the alleged date of occurrence the petitioner and other co-accused persons came on the shop of informant along with deadly weapon for robbery and brutally assaulted the informant and took away Rs. 60000/- from the Galla. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to commit theft. On further perusal I find that the petitioner is in custody since 12.08.2025 and police has submitted chargesheet against the petitioner. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and keeping in view the period of custody, the petitioner Amlesh Yadav is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.
