This anticipatory bail petition filed on 24.02.2026 under section 482 B.N.S.S. on behalf of the above named petitioner **1. Prem Thakur @ Prem Kumar Thakur & 2. Aso Lal Thakur @ Ashok Kumar Sharma**, who are apprehending his arrest in connection with **Laukahi P.S. Case No. 28/2026**, for the offence **under section 190, 191(2), 191(3), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109, 76, 351(2), 324(4), 303(2), 352, 333, 126(2) of the B.N.S.**, which is pending in the court of Md. N. Kamran, J.M. 1st Class, Jhanjharpur is being pressed and heard.

The prosecution case in brief is that the informant of this case is Sangeeta Devi and has stated that on 24.02.2026 at about 08:30 PM in the night, informant and all his family members went to sleep after having dinner. At the same time petitioner accused persons named in F.I.R came with weapons in her courtyard, and started abusing because of old disputes. When the informant came then petitioner accused person namely Uday Thakur assaulted by means of Dabiya to the informant that caused injury. It is further stated that all other co-accused persons named in F.I.R assaulted the family members of the informant, and also looted 19 anas of gold mangalsutra, and 8 ana mangalsutra. Hence, this case.

Learned counsel for the accused petitioners submitted that no other bail petition is pending earlier before your Hon'ble Court, or before Hon'ble Patna High Court, Patna. There is no criminal antecedent against the petitioners. It is further stated that the petitioners are quite innocent, and have not committed any offence. That the total case story is false, concocted, and this false case has been lodged against the petitioner due to grudge, malice, spite, and dirty village party politics. It is further stated that there is delay in lodging of F.I.R. That all sections are bailable only section 118(1), 109, 76, 303(2) of B.N.S, which are not made out against the petitioner. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. That there is no intention to cause death of the informant by the petitioner. Accordingly, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the accused petitioner.

Learned APP had opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Heard the argument and perused the case diary. Petitioner do not bear any criminal antecedent. From document submitted on behalf of petitioner, it is apparent that there is a case and counter case, regarding the same date occurrence, vide Laukahi P.S case no-28/2026, and 31/2026, respectively. Meaning thereby that free fight took place. From perusal of typed complaint of Laukhai P.S case no-31/26, it is apparent that fight took place regarding dispute over street. Injury sustained by injured persons are simple in nature, caused by hard and blunt substance. Considering all these facts and circumstances, this court find this to be an apt case for grant of anticipatory bail. Hence, anticipatory bail petition of petitioners **Prem Thakur @ Prem Kumar Thakur & Aso Lal Thakur @ Ashok Kumar Sharma** is **allowed**. It is hereby ordered that in the event of surrender of arrest before the court below/concerned police within 30 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/police subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) BNSS.
