	01.07.2026	1. This is the anticipatory bail application U/s – 482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused persons namely 1. Md. Tauhid @ Md Tohir aged about 26 years S/o- Md. Juman 2.Md. Riyaj aged about 26 years S/o- Mujibul @ Md. Majibul, 3.Md. Yeraj aged about 30 years S/o- Md. Majibul & 4. Md. Tausim aged about 27 years S/o- Md. Badrudin All R/o Vill-Ghormohana, P.S.- Lalmaniya, District- Madhubani in connection with Laukaha P.S case No- 198/2023 Gr.No.- 1334/2023 U/s- 147, 149, 341, 342, 323, 332, 333, 353, 427, 504, 506 of IPC. 2. Heard Sri Satish Bharti for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent, have not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that petitioners have no criminal antecedents. It was also submitted that the petitioners are local and there is no chance of their absconding, if they be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioners on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in brief is that on Bipin Kumar Yadav is Police Officer and was posted as O.P. in-charge of Lalmaniya OP on the alleged date of occurrence 20.07.2023 and he has alleged that at 11:00 AM he got information that a panchayati is being held at village Ghormohna and in that panchayati one person is being assaulted and he has been tied with rope and thereafter informant alongwith some other police personnel went there and he found that one person has been confined and all the accused persons named in the FIR including this petitioner and some unknown accused persons numbering 50 to 60 had	

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	cont. 01.07.2026	assembled there and they become aggressive on seeing police team and started pelting stones on informant and other police personnels. Informant also alleged that Md. Kurban and Md. Masibulla tried to ignite police vehicle and Md. Ibran pushed police personnel. 6. Perused the case record. From perusal of the case record, LCR and submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record, it transpires that there are 22 FIR named accused persons and alleged Section 353 IPC is one non-bailable section. There is allegation of assault of one person by tying him. When police party reached then all attacked police party. There is no specific allegation on this petitioner. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners namely 1. Md. Tauhid @ Md Tohir , 2. Md. Riyaj , 3.Md. Yeraj & 4. Md. Tausim, are hereby allowed. In the event of arrest/surrender by the petitioner within 21 days of the receipt/production of the order, they are directed to be released on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned with an undertaking under section 482(2) of BNSS .
