This anticipatory bail petition filed under section 482 B.N.S.S. on behalf of the above named petitioners **1. Om Prakash Rai, 2. Gulshan Rai @ Gulshan Kumar Rai, 3. Arvind Rai @ Arvind Kumar Rai, 4. Manju Devi @ Manjula Devi, 5. Lakshmi Rai & 6. Mamta Devi** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with **Phulparas P.S. Case No. 43/2025** for the offence **under section 126(2), 115(2), 118, 109, 352, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS** which is pending in the court of ACJM-II, Jhanjharpur is being pressed and heard.

The case of the prosecution in nutshell, on the basis of typed application of the informant Lalita Devi is that on 23.10.2025 at about 11 AM-12 forenoon, her son Dev Narayan Bhar came from the pond to his residence. When he came from near the pond at a distance of 500 yards towards east of two bighas, all the accused petitioners reached near to the informant's son, and assaulted him. When the informant tried to rescue him, then the accused Gulshan Rai assaulted with tengari on her head. Other accused persons have assaulted with slap and fist to the informant. Accused Arvind Rai tore the blouse of the informant, and the

accused Manju Devi took away silver chain 10 bhar from the possession of the informant. Hence, this case.

Learned counsel for the accused petitioners submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent, and have not committed any offence. They have been implicated in this false case due to previous enmity. The prosecution case is entirely false, concocted, baseless, and absurd. That no occurrence as alleged did ever took place. The allegation against the petitioners is vague and false. There is no any specific allegation against the petitioners. Nothing incriminating articles has recovered from the possession of the petitioners. There is no any criminal antecedent against the petitioners. The petitioners are major. A compromise petition filed on behalf of the both parties. Accordingly, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.

Learned APP had opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Heard the argument, and perused the record. Petitioners do not bear any criminal antecedent. There is a case and counter case regarding the same occurrence. Meaning thereby that free fight took place. Injury sustained by injured are simple in nature. Moreover, both parties have compromise the matter, and informant as well as injured have supported the factum of compromise in Court. Considering the aforesaid facts as well as discussion made above, the Anticipatory Bail Petition of the petitioners accused namely **Om Prakash Rai, Gulshan Rai @ Gulshan Kumar Rai, Arvind Rai @ Arvind Kumar Rai, Manju Devi @ Manjula Devi, Lakshmi Rai & Mamta Devi** is hereby **allowed**. It is hereby ordered that in the event of surrender or arrest before the court below/concerned police within 30 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/police subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) BNSS.
