	27.04.2026	1. This is the anticipatory bail application U/s – 482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused persons namely 1. Devendra Singh aged about 55 years S/o- Late Pitamber Singh, 2. Nirmila Devi aged about 50 years W/o- Devendra Singh, 3. Naveen Kumar, aged about 33 years S/o- Devendra Singh and 4. Priya Singh aged about 25 years W/o-Navin Kumar, All R/o- Village-Tendaraha, PS- Rampurheer, District Muzaffarpur in connection with C.R case No- 74/2025, U/s- 115(1), 126, 127, 303, 351, 85 of BNS 2. Heard Sri Anand Kumar Jha for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent, have not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. It was further submitted that petitioners no-1 and 2 both are old age persons and living separately and petitioner no-3 and 4 are living in other city for their livelihood. It was also submitted that the complainant behavior was aggressive and without any reason disturbance attitude has been started. It was also submitted that the petitioners are local and there is no chance of their absconding, if they be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioners on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in brief is that petitioners demanded dowry of three lakh rupees for purchase of rest of dowry items and on refusal they tortured the complainant and ousted from the matrimonial house. 6. Perused the case record. From perusal of the case record, L.C.R and submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record, I find that the petitioners are in laws and there is no specific allegation against the petitioners. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners namely 1. Devendra Singh, 2. Nirmila Devi, 3. Naveen Kumar and 4.
