This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely 1.Surya Narayan Mandal 2.Laxmi Devi 3.Pitambar Mandal seeking pre-arrest bail, in connection with Ghoghardiha P.S Case No- 39/2026, U/s- 69, 89, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS 2. Heard Smt. Ranjeeta Kumari, Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioners and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. counsel of the petitioner Smt. Ranjeeta Kumari has submitted that the no bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been filed earlier either before this Ld. Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna and petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitiones are innocent and have not committed any offence and the petitioners are involved in this case only to marry Pappu Mandal with the informant. It is also submitted that neither section 69 nor section 89 of BNS is made out against the petitioners and the case is only an instrument to make pressure to agree for marriage and blackmail. It is also submitted that petitioner No.1 is teacher, living in Sitamadhi and petitioner No.3 is Railway employee. Lastly, it is submitted that petitioners are apprehending their arrest, Ld. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in brief is that the informant of this case has alleged	

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Contd... 05.05.2026	that one Pappu Kumar Mandal has sexually exploited her by pretext of marriage and ultimately he denied for marriage and when informant went to Pappu Kumar Mandal's family and requested for marriage, then all the accused persons demanded Rs. 5 lacs rupee, household articles and Bullet Motorcycle. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both side at the length and perused the case record along with case diary available. From perusal of the record it transpires that on the basis of computer typed application given by the informant victim before SHO Ghoghardiha this very case has been registered against the petitioners and others U/s- 69, 89, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS. From perusal it also transpires that as per allegation co-accused Pappu Kumar Mandal sexually exploited to the informant by pretext of marriage and petitioners accused are mother, father and full brother of the co-accused Pappu Kumar Mandal. From perusal it also transpires that there is no any specific allegation against the petitioners accused rather the main allegation is on one Pappu Kumar Mandal, who is not the petitioner in this instant anticipatory bail petition. Apart from that from perusal of the case diary para No. 39, the victim informant has not alleged any allegation against the petitioners and in para No. 41 of the case diary no medical evidence of sexual assault is found at the time of examination of the informant victim, who is about 20 years of age and as per para No. 54 of the case diary, no any criminal antecedent is found against the petitioners accused.

Therefore, considering the facts and circumstances discussed above as well as clean antecedent and general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners accused, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail accordingly, petitioners namely, 1.Surya Narayan Mandal 2. Laxmi Devi 3. Pitambar Mandal, are directed to be enlarged on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within a period of 21 days from receipt of this order, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld.
