This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely Govind Choudhary, seeking pre-arrest bail, in connection with Bhairabsthan P.S case No- 155/2025, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 74, 109, 76, 352, 3(5) of the BNS. 2. Heard Sri Rishi Kumar Jha Ld. Advocate, on behalf of petitioner and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. counsel of the petitioner Sri Rishi Kumar Jha has submitted that earlier no any bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner either before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna and petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case due to malice, enmity and dirty village politics. It is also submitted that prosecution story is entirely false and concocted and no occurrence as alleged has ever been taken place and there is inordinate delay in filing the case, which creates serious doubt of the prosecution story and petitioner is the pattidar and neighbours of the informant. It is also submitted that allegation U/s 74, 76 & 109 of the BNS is not made out against the petitioner. Lastly, it is submitted that petitioner has apprehended his arrest in this case, and Ld. Counsel prays to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the petition and prayed

The prosecution story in brief is that, informant of this case is Pan Dai Devi, on 29.10.2025 at about 08:20 P.M., due to quarrel of children all the accused persons named in FIR including this petitioner armed with lathi, danda, rod etc., entered into her courtyard by abusing, on protest all of them assaulted her by means of fist, slap and lathi and on instigation of Mithun Choudhary, Govind Choudhary assaulted her by means of knife, resulted she got head injury and she fell down on the ground and all the accused persons also assaulted her by means of lathi, danda, fist etc, when her son and daughter-in-law came to save, they also assaulted them and in course of that one Govind Choudhary tore her saree and blouse, resulted she became naked and one Gunja Devi snatched mangalsutra of Rs. 65000/- Hence, this case. 6. Heard both side at length and perused the case record along with case diary and injury report of the victim informant. From perusal it transpires that, on the basis of computer typed application given by the victim informant namely Pan Dai Devi before SHO Bhairabsthan P.S, this very case has been registered U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 74, 109, 76, 352, 3(5) of the BNS against petitioner and other accused persons. From perusal of the record it transpires that as per allegation, accused petitioner assaulted to the informant by means of knife with intention to kill, resulted she sustained injury over her forehead and she fell down on the ground and all the accused persons also assaulted her by means of lathi, danda, fist etc, when her son and daughter-in-law came to save, they also assaulted

	Contd. 07.05.2026	them but from perusal of the injury report it transpires that as per injury report of the victim informant, no any obvious external injury seen on her body and injuries are simple in nature. From perusal of the injury report, it transpires that injury report does not corroborate the case of the prosecution. 7. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as omnibus and general allegation and injury found simple in nature, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail accordingly, petitioner namely, Govind Choudhary, is directed to be enlarged on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within a period of 21 days from receipt of this order, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld.
