This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely Abhimanyu Yadav, who is under custody since 13.01.2026, in connection with Ghoghardiha P.S Case No- 95/2023, U/s- 341, 323, 324, 307, 504, 506, 34 of the IPC. 2. Heard Sri Satish Bharti, Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioner and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. counsel of the petitioner Sri Satish Bharti has submitted that no other bail petition has been filed on behalf of this petitioner either before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna and petitioner has eight criminal antecedents. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence and the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this false case due to dirty party politics and enmity and prosecution case is totally false, baseless and concocted. It is also submitted that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner in FIR. Lastly, it is submitted that petitioner is under custody since 13.01.2026, Ld. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in brief is that the informant of this case is Pappu Kumar he has alleged that on 12.06.2023 at about 08:00 AM he was getting his house reconstructed by labourers during that accused persons named in FIR including this petitioner came there armed with lathi, iron rod and	

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Contd... 12.05.2026	started abusing him along with labourers and directed to stop construction work, on protest accused persons started abusing and Suresh Yadav and Lalan Kumar assaulted to the informant by means of iron rod over his head and when uncle of the informant came there then accused Abhimanyu Yadav and Kanhaiya Yadav assaulted him by means of iron rod and later on they were taken to DMCH for treatment. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at the length and perused the case record along with LCR including case diary. From perusal of the record it transpires that on the basis of fardbyan made by the informant victim Pappu Kumar this case has been registered against petitioner and others U/s- 341, 323, 324, 307, 504, 506, 34 of the IPC. From perusal of the FIR it transpires that accused petitioner has assaulted on the head of one Lal Babu Yadav, by means of iron rod. From perusal of the record it also transpires that after due investigation charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner. However, on several repeated direction prosecution fails to produce injury report and petitioner is under custody since 13.01.2026 inspite of that there is case and counter case and land dispute in between the parties. From perusal it also transpires that the persons of both the sides sustained injury and after completion of investigation charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner. 7. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and discussions made above as well as detention period of accused, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner, namely Abhimanyu Yadav on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount subject to condition as mentioned U/s
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
