Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Sita Ram Mukhiya , S/o- Late Uttim Mukhiya, aged about- 50 years R/o Village -Mohanpur, PS.- Pandaul, District Madhubani, in connection with Bhairabasthan P.S Case No- 62/2023 Gr.No.-893/2023 , U/s- 304(B),201/34 of IPC. 2. Heard Sri Mahendra Kamati, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no other regular bail petition has been filed earlier on behalf of the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further stated that petitioner has no any criminal antecedent. It has further been stated that petitioner has never any demanded of dowry from the deceased Puja Kumari. It has further been stated that petitioner is separate from the accused Ram Bahadur Mukhiya and there is no any concern in this family. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. 4. The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case according to informant in short is that Puja Kumari daughter of informant named with Ram Bahadur Mukhiya on 21.06.2021 as per Hindu Culture and custom. It is further stated that after marriage daughter of the informant Puja Kumari was living in her sasural with her Husband and after some time the petitioners and co-accused persons demanded in dowry one motorcycle and cash Rs. 50,000 through her parents when the victim Puja Kumari protested to the accused persons the accused persons abused and assaulted to the victim Puja Kumari given an information to the informant and his family members want to the marriage place and after mediates return at his house. It is further stated that the petitioners and other co-accused persons assaulted to the victim Puja and it is further stated that on 13.02.2022 the petitioner along with other co-accused persons committed murder at matrimonial house. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to commit murder of Puja Kumari for not fulfillment of dowry . On further perusal of case record I	

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08.06.2026	find that informant has filed one compromise petition on 30.03.2026 in which it has been mentioned that this case has been compromised between the parties and they did not want to contest this case further. On further perusal of case record I find that the petitioner is in custody since 26.03.2026 and charge sheet have already been submitted by police. Further the petitioner has clean antecedent and informant has no objection. Further co-accused Ram Bahadur Mukhiya has been granted Bail in BP No. 449/2025. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and keeping in view the period of custody, the petitioner Sita Ram Mukhiya is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, with an undertaking under section 437 (3) Cr.P.C, to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned and with further condition that the petitioner will not be involved in case of similar nature in future and will co-operate in trial. <u>Further the petitioner will file bail bond after framing of charge.</u> Dictated and corrected by Anil Kumar Ram District & Additional Sessions Judge III Jhanjharpur	
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
